

By underground and train King's is about 5 minutes walk from Denmark Hill. 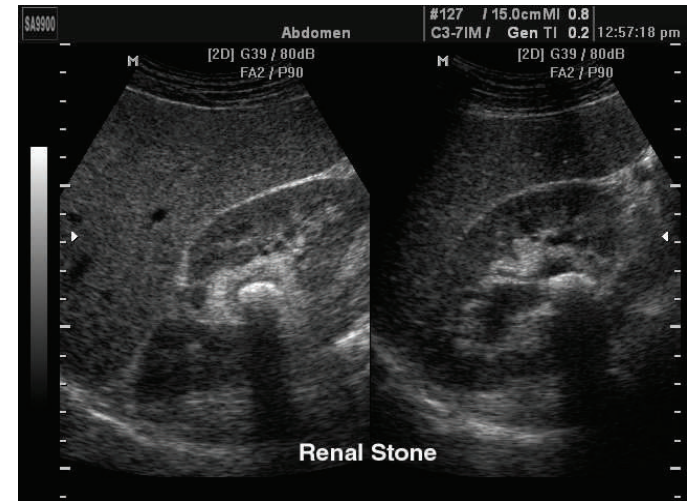


Essential Ultrasound for Nephrologists Study Day

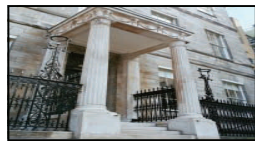
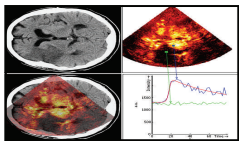
Tuesday 29th September 2009

- Apply these principles in practice to the procedures of line insertion and kidney biopsy

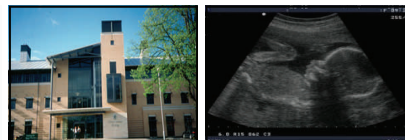

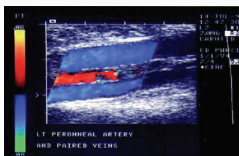
